“One Another”

Have you ever considered how many times in the New Testament the words “One Another” are used? Over 50 times! This amount is significant. The Holy Spirit of God wants us to know that we need “One Another.” God never intended for man to walk in this world alone. Loneliness brings misery and makes us vulnerable to the enemy (See 1 Peter 5:8). Solitude may be helpful for brief periods of study, prayer, reflection or relaxation, but soon we feel the tug toward and the need for “One Another.”

The early church found that being “Together” was the best way to strengthen people and combat the pressure from the enemy. While collective worship on Sunday was (is) uncompromisingly imperative, Small Groups were (are) also indispensable in building relationships and a faithful walk (See Acts 2:46 and 5:42). The connections they formed in Christ gave them strength and caused them to grow (See Acts 2:47).

Beginning January 7th, WBCOC will launch a brand-new effort simply called, “Small Groups.” These *Small Groups* will enable us to better support “One Another.” It is biblical. It is practical. Matthew 6:25-34

25 "Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink, nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? **26** Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? **27** And which of you by being anxious can add a single hour to his span of life? **28** And why are you anxious about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin, **29** yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. **30** But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is alive and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will he not much more clothe you, O you of little faith? **31** Therefore do not be anxious, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' **32** For the Gentiles seek after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them all. **33** But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you. **34** "Therefore do not be anxious about tomorrow, for tomorrow will be anxious for itself. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.

One way that Satan attacks us is through worry, and sadly it works all too often. It works because worry takes our attention from God and weakens our faith. Instead we should focus on God and His will for us and He will take care of the rest.
