The old King James Version of the Bible reads in 2 Timothy 2:15, "Study to show thyself approved to God, a workman who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." The New King James Version states, "Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." The New American Standard version reads, "Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth." All three, as well as many others, indicate that a student of the word must put him or herself into the word of God so that it is handled as God intended.

Do you handle the word of God correctly? Do you read and meditate upon it daily? Are you hungering amid thirsting for it as you do for your everyday food? 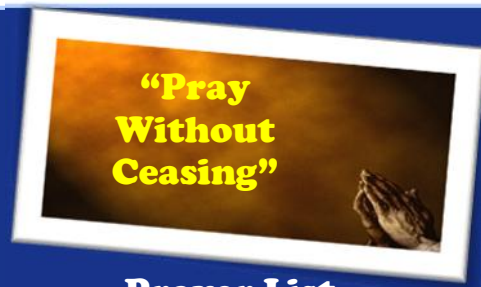
9 Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because this man, too, is a son of Abraham. 10 For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost."

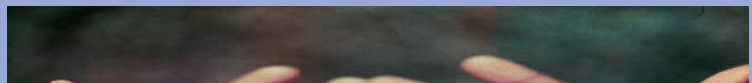
