

HAITI UPDATE

September 13, 2021

Beloved Coworkers:

It has been a very hectic Monday for me. First, the power went off more times I can remember. Second, they messed us up counting the bags of rice, so we had to offload them and count them again. Not easy when there is no device to to the heavy lifting for us. Well, we got it all done. Now the truck is on the way to Haiti. Our Timothy teams repack the rice with drinking water, cooking oil and more. Every one in the church will receive a package. I tried to send this report along with the picture but it did not send it. Here it is again. I am so proud of our TEAMS for doing all this.

I just came home, it is 5:10pm and it is time to get ready for my evening class (7-10pm).

We had a great Sunday morning service yesterday. Jaques taught the Bible class and I preached later. The afternoon was spent locating the best rice deals and the most reliable trucks. Most of the disaster aid is being bought in Haiti though. Prices are about the same as the items are here in the Dominican Republic. Our rice here in the DR is of much better quality though.

Later that afternoon we came right in time to preach for the church in Esperanza, halfway between Puerto Plata and Dajabon, the border. About 45 minutes from POP.

I want to thank you again for your generous contributions that made all this possible. I want to tell you though, as the funds for Haiti were a bit

delayed, all the churches in our ministry that were not affected by the Quake and the Hurricane pitched in right away to help with the most important things. I praise God for their help.

Over 40 church buildings in the south of Haiti were damaged, some totally destroyed. We will help where we can and rebuild. Haiti seems to not get a break. Could it be other forces try to hinder God's work in that God fearing country?

I just want to thank you again for your participation in this disaster aid. Lives were being saved and are being saved now because of your generosity.
