Dear Co-Workers in the kingdom.

Greetings to you all. I pray this short report finds you all doing well. I am well, even though the past 6 weeks have been brutally hot in Puerto Plata. I am a bit tired as we are trying to make up for lost time because of Covid19. We are making good progress. Even though our evening class (from 7-10) is demanding, our students are in no hurry to go home. There are so many questions (good questions). I like that a lot because the great questions show how much our students have grown.

I have been in contact with the preachers and some of the elders in Haiti about their situation. Most were so grateful for the food relief they received. They all asked me to make sure to thank each and every one of you for that noble and much needed effort. Some preachers told me that indeed some lives were saved. So many people went for days without food and water. You can imagine the joy in our congregations when the food trucks arrived with much needed supplies.

The church secretary from the West Broward church of Christ just told me that an additional \$5,000 for earthquake relief had been received. That money will pay for the reconstruction of 3 church buildings. All three are in similar shape (see picture) and they will be fixed. There are however nearly 40 buildings that were damaged, from almost total destruction to light damage. We are so thankful for the \$5,000. It will help us to rebuild.

I thank you again for your generous contributions. It is so good to know there are brothers and sisters that care to help. Lives were indeed being saved and you all did not only help to save lives, over the years you have helped to save precious souls. Thank you.
